Community Services Building, 801 W. Vine Street (just S.W. of the Adams Street viaduct), from 8:00 - 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. They are also open the first Saturday of each month from 8:00 - 12:00, and all other Saturdays from 1:00 - 4:00 p.m.
